White and yarn dyed woven labels made of 100 % polyester, white and pigment printed labels made of 100 % polyester (base colours off-white and black), recycled polyester satin label (base colour white), made of 100 % cotton (base colour off-white) and 100 % polyamide taffeta ribbon (base colour white) as well as heat transfer printed labels on foil for print application on garments; produced by using materials certified according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®.
